TANA-WIS-QUA

This newly developed campsite is available for use starting January 1st. The Tana-wis-qua campsite was largely funded by Ashokwahta Lodge and built by the lodge members called the Dewalt Crew.

The site contains 6 lean-to's, with 4 bunks each, and a rebuilt larger hut that also contains 4 bunks. All units have a door opening that is covered with fire retardant canvas that can be slid shut to keep out the weather.

Total bunk space for the site is 28 cots.

Rental fee will be \$50.00 per week-end
