Order of the Arrow Provides Needed Tasks for Council Camps



Each year we as a lodge travel to different troops though out our council to run elections of youth to become new members of our lodge. All members of the lodge are welcome to be a part of this procedure. We would welcome anyone who could do some, whether it is 1 or 3-4, All we need to do is go over the correct procedures with you, and make sure you have the correct forms, and you can be a part of this important function of our lodge. We hope to do most of them in the months of Feb. and March. It is best for a Troop to schedule it for just after their members have completed a push for rank advancement, as that allows all that are deserving to be a part of the election. A youth must be 1st class, have 15 nights of camping in the last 2 years, and have the approval of his unit leader.

If the troop elects a youth to membership, they may nominate 1 adult to be considered for membership. The adult must still meet the same camping requirement as the youth members do. The lodge leadership will consider the nominations and invite those that are chosen. This is not a automatic selection, so the nomination form should be filled out completely, as those making the final decision may not know the individual.

We will go over these forms at the Dec. LEC meeting as well as have them at the Jan. Banquet. We are scheduled to have someone at all 3 roundtables in Jan. to sign troops up for an election.



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
